Harry Potter and the Goblet of Fire

Harry Potter and the Half-Blood Prince

The evil Lord Voldemort (Ralph Fiennes) is back and he's creating an army, his presence is making an appearance in both wizard and muggle worlds. Even Hogwarts is under pressure and is no longer as safe as it once was. Dumbledore (Michael Gambon) realises that there will soon be a battle on an epic scale of good vs. evil, and he must prepare. Harry Potter and the Deathly Hallows – Part 1
