MORE THAN ATHES





RAHEEM STERLING HAS USED HIS PLATOFRM TO SPEAK OUT AGAINST RACISM IN FOOTBALL AS WELL AS THE MISTREATMENT OF BLACK FOOTBALL PLAYERS BY THE MEDIA. RAHEEM HAS SPOKEN OUT ABOUT THE NEED FOR FOOTBALL PLAYERS AND THOSE IN POSITIONS OF INFLUENCE TO USE THEIR VOICES TO MAKE A DIFFERENCE. IN A RECENT INTERVIEW ABOUT THE BLACK LIVES MATTER MOVEMENT, HE STATED: "AND AT THIS MOMENT IN TIME, THERE'S ONLY SO MUCH PEOPLE CAN TAKE. THERE'S ONLY SO MUCH COMMUNITIES AND OTHER BACKGROUNDS CAN TAKE - ESPECIALLY BLACK PEOPLE. IT'S BEEN GOING ON FOR HUNDREDS OF YEARS AND PEOPLE ARE TIRED AND PEOPLE ARE READY FOR CHANGE."

IAN WRIGHT HAS BECOME ONE OF THE COUNTRY'S' MOST RESPECTED AND WELL KNOWN PUNDITS SINCE RETIRING FROM PLAYING PROFESSIONAL FOOTBALL. HOWEVER, HE HAS USED HIS PLATFORM TO DO MUCH MORE THAN HIS JOB ASKS OF HIM. IAN ACTS AS A MENTOR AND COACH TO YOUNGER PLAYERS IN THE GAME; OFFERING THEM SUPPORT AND GUIDANCE WITH THE CHALLENGING AND, AT TIMES, HARSH REALITIES OF COMING UP IN THE GAME AND BEING CONSTANTLY UNDER THE SPOTLIGHT OF SCRUTINY.


