There will be at least two roles up for grabs at 83 stores in either the Click & Collect service support teams or the multichannel service support teams, creating opportunities for young people across the country. These roles focus on providing brilliant service and will make shopping in our stores even easier for our customers, and the recruits will become a core part of the Homebase team.

The six-month Scheme will include training throughout, giving each young person the opportunity to gain both valuable skills and experience. From stock management processes, digital sales, customer relationship management and health and safety processes, to problem solving, organisation and teamwork, these are just some of the skills that Homebase's new team members can expect to learn and take with them into their future careers.
