

IMPORTANT - Remove any packaging before use, but retain the safety instructions. Please read and follow the instructions before using the Chimenea, failure to do so may result in a fire, property damage, serious injury or death. We suggest you carry out assembly on a soft surface so as to avoid scratching the paint.

Check you have all components before proceeding.

WARNINGS - CAUTION!

- This product is intended FOR OUTDOOR USE ONLY.
- NEVER leave a burning fire unattended.
- DANGER of carbon monoxide poisoning NEVER light this product or let it smoulder or cool down in confined spaces.
- FIRE HAZARD Hot embers may emit while in use.
- **DO NOT** use petrol, white spirit, lighter fluid, alcohol or other similar chemicals to light a fire as this may cause severe damage to the Chimenea.
- This product is ONLY suitable for use with untreated wood, La Hacienda Heat Logs or Easy Logs.
- DO NOT use this Chimenea on decking or any other flammable surfaces such as dry grass, wood chips, leaves or decorative bark.
- This product is **NOT** intended for cooking or heating food.
- **DO NOT** use this Chimenea as a furnace **ONLY** use as a patio heater.
- Ensure that the Chimenea is positioned at least 2 metres away from flammable items.
- DO NOT handle or move the Chimenea whilst alight as it could become hot.
- Keep children and pets at a safe distance from the Chimenea when in use.
- Always inspect the Chimenea prior to use for fatigue and damage and replace as and when necessary.

Care and maintenance

CARE & USE

- Ensure that the Chimenea is positioned on a permanent flat, level, heat resistant non-flammable surface away from flammable items. Ensure the Chimenea does not wobble.
- Ensure Chimenea has a minimum of 2 metres overhead clearance and has a minimum of 2 metres clearance from other surrounding items.
- Decide on the location and assemble the Chimenea as directed in the instructions. The
 assembled Chimenea is heavy so it is recommended the unit is assembled at the desired
 location to avoid lifting. Two persons are required to lift the assembled unit if it has to be
 moved. **DO NOT** drag the Chimenea across the floor.
- This Chimenea does not require any curing or outer sealant protection before use. The unit may be left outside all year if a La Hacienda Chimenea Cover is used.
- The high temperature paint coating will require re-coating every 4-6 months using La Hacienda High Temperature Paint.
- As this Chimenea is made from Steel, the Chimenea surface will start to rust as soon as it is
 placed outside. This is not a fault and is to be expected. To slow rusting, wipe the Chimenea
 surface after it has cooled completely with an oily rag after each use.
- If the Chimenea surface becomes scratched or chipped the damaged area should be re-coated with La Hacienda High Temperature Paint.
- Always inspect the Chimenea for fatigue and damage prior to use and replace as and when necessary.

STARTING A FIRE

- To start a fire, place a small quantity of kindling wood and rolled newspaper in the unit on top
 of the log grate. Light the paper and allow a flame to build up. Once sufficiently alight add logs
 or larger pieces of untreated wood to the unit to increase the heat slowly.
- **DO NOT** overload the unit with fuel. If the fire is too intense this could damage the Chimenea.
- Fuel should never protrude from the front opening of the Chimenea.
- ALWAYS USE HEAT RESISTANT GLOVES DURING THE HANDLING PROCESS.


EXTINGUISHING

- To extinguish the unit stop adding fuel and allow the fire in the Chimenea to die or douse with sand.
- DO NOT use water, as this could damage the Chimenea.

STORAGE

If using an outdoor cover, only position once the fire has died and unit has completely cooled.

Please ensure you have all the parts listed below.

Components - Fittings


Please check you have all the fittings listed below

Note: The quantities below are the correct amount to complete the assembly. In some cases more fittings may be supplied than are required.

Bolt M6 x 25mm x6 Sets of bolts, washers, lock washers and nuts	Bolt M6 x 20mm x6 Sets of bolts, washers, lock washers and nuts	Bracket x3
x6 Washer	x6 Lock Washer	x6 Nut

Step 1


Attach the 3 x legs to the bottom bowl using 2 x lock washers, washers and nuts onto the pre-attached headless bolts on legs.



Step 2


Using the 3 small brackets provided, fit the top bowl to the bottom bowl. The brackets are attached to the inside of the bowl. Use 2 x 20mm bolts lock washers, washers and nuts per bracket.

Do not fully tighten the bolts until the model has been fully assembled. Do not over tighten as this may cause damage.




Step 3

Add the main flue and attach using 3 x 25mm bolts with lock washer, washers and nuts.




Step 4

Add the top flue and attach using 3 x 25mm bolts with lock washers, washer and nuts.




Step 5

Attach the side handles to the top bowl using pre-attached headless bolts and by placing the included lock washer and washer to the inside of the top bowl before adding the nut and tightening.



Step 6

Attach mesh door to top bowl using 2 x pre-attached bolts and nuts. Attach mesh door latch to top bowl using 2 x pre-attached bolts and nuts. Attach mesh door handle to mesh door using pre-attached bolt and nut. Place fuel grate sections into the bottom of the Chimenea.



Step 7

Insert flue grate into the top flue.

Your Chimenea is ready to use once all nuts and bolts are fully tightened, however **DO NOT** over tighten.
